

KINGSBURY/SSP LEADERSHIP & VOLUNTEERING AWARDS

Each year the Department for Education and Skills (DfES) and the Department for Culture Media and Sport (DCMS) conduct a survey of all schools progress towards meeting the aims of the national PE, School Sport and Club Link strategy.

One of the Key questions (10) looks at recording the number of students actively involved in sports volunteering and leadership. This question is looking to record and recognise students who have received volunteering and leadership training and also students who informally volunteer/lead.

With this in mind a pilot award has been introduced which will aid your school to improve its figures for question 10. The pilot scheme will run from January 2008-July 2008. After which the partnership will look to evaluate by examining the PESSCL results and student and staff feedback.

This Award Aims To:

- Recognise your student's achievements.
- Increase your PESSCL figures.

Who is it for?

- All students from Years 1-13 who meet the criteria.

How does it work?

Each partnership school will receive

- A list of the criteria to display to students
- A set of certificates to distribute to students
- A recording log to record the number of certificates distributed (this will aid the schools data collection to answer question 10 and also act as evidence if your schools data collection is audited)

At the end of the pilot the partnership will require a copy of your schools recording sheet and a completed evaluation sheet by staff and students which can be down loaded from the partnerships website.
